SCAM TARGETS CREDIT UNION

Recently, a series of email, phone, and cell phone/text scams, have occurred. These scams include statements such as your credit card has been suspended, or an email stating a problem with validating your ATM PIN, and limitations being placed on your account. Plus, emails asking for account information

Please know that Bull's Eye Credit Union member's information **Has Not Been Compromised**, and that your confidential information is safe and secure.

It is so very important to remember to safe guard your information. Financial institutions will not ask for your information as they already have it. In another event, if you receive a call, letter or email asking for account details, please remember some of these tips!

1. If you receive a telephone or cell phone call requesting personal, or financial information, please hang up and call the business back at their phone number, do not call the number provided by the person contacting you.
2. If you are requested through a phone call or email to provide your credit card information, please call the 1-800 number on the back of your card to verify the request.
3. If you receive an email requesting personal or financial information, please contact the business to make sure the request is legitimate.
4. While home banking and e-commerce are very safe as a general rule, you should be careful in giving your personal financial information over the Internet. Always ensure that you are using a secure website when submitting credit card or other sensitive information. Check the beginning web address in your browser, as it should begin with https.
